In my role as a Research Assistant in the Developmental Dynamics Lab, under the guidance of Dr. Drew Abney and the mentorship of Christian Jerry, I have actively contributed to our mission of investigating how behaviors and social interactions impact developmental trajectories from infancy through toddlerhood. My responsibilities include:

- Infant Pose Coding: Reviewed videos of parent-infant dyads and coded positions of the child with correlating timestamps in Datavyu. Meticulous attention to detail contributed to the reliability of our data analysis in looking at movement of infants, as well as the training of a machine learning software to track movement through the use of accelerometry.
- Session Notebook Data Entry: Reviewed and transferred handwritten data collected in notebooks by participants at different sessions into online spreadsheets. Utilized MATLAB to standardize data for use in analysis.

- Weekly Meeting Participation: Actively participated in weekly meetings, where I provided updates on coding progress and collaborated with fellow team members. These meetings served as a platform for discussing project developments and fostering effective communication within the research team.
- **Project design and implementation:** Reviewed dataset from previous study (Family Interaction Project) and initiated a secondary analysis under the guidance of Dr. Abney to address a question not posed with the dataset previously. This analysis is currently in progress.
